- Title:** KIC Volunteer
- Purpose:** To create a safe after-school environment for children. Develop relationships with the children and to build them up emotionally, physically, socially, and spiritually. Teach the children Biblical principles and life skills.
- Target Group:** Children in grades 1-6
- Responsibilities:**
- Help set up the room and prepare activities.
 - Participate in the activities (praise & worship, Bible lessons, tutoring, games, sports, cooking etc.)
 - Some volunteers may choose to help lead activities (such as Bible, arts and crafts, games, homework, etc).
 - Build healthy relationships with children and stay for debriefing at the end of each session.
- Skills & Qualifications:**
- Must enjoy working with children in grades 1-6.
 - An enthusiastic attitude towards activities and a desire to be a positive role model.
- Reports to:** Community Worker
- Time Commitment:** 3.5 hours/week for 8-10 weeks per session
