Target Group:	Children grades 1-8, possibly grades 9-12 in certain communities
Responsibilities:	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• As a tutor, you will be expected to attend your tutoring session every week or inform the Tutoring Program Director of your absence 24 hours beforehand when possible.• Be excited to work with your student and be willing to encourage them.• Tutors are expected to stay for debriefing at the end of each session.
Skills & Qualifications:	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• This volunteer position requires a willing heart to care for a child and the ability to be patient as the child develops their skills.• Other qualifications include a basic comprehension of elementary math, reading, and writing.

Time Commitment:	2 hours a week for 8-10 weeks per session <i>(Time commitment may vary with each location)</i>
Locations:	St. Jamestown (<i>Sherbourne & Bloor</i>) Willowtree (<i>Willowdale & Finch</i>) Steeles/L'Amoureux (<i>Warden & Finch</i>)
Orientation & Training:	All tutors are required to attend training and orientation before the tutoring session begins.
Benefits:	The benefits are experience working with children, realization of that joy that comes from service, and the knowledge of making a difference in the life of a child by encouraging them to grow.
